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On Thursday, September 28, 2017 at approximately 1304 hours I, (Sergeant Jason Newman) was dispatched to 890 Goose Island Road in reference to a dog bit call. Dispatch advised a female was found lying on the ground with a dog bite to her neck. They also advised she was barely breathing. I advised dispatch I would be en-route code three (lights and siren) to the aforementioned location. While en-route dispatched advised there would be a silver car and a van parked in the driveway.

Upon my arrival at approximately 1310 hours I observed the aforementioned vehicles and the victim (Kathy Nichelson) lying on the ground. I parked just below the driveway exiting my patrol car retrieving gloves and gauze for her wounds. As I approached the male victim (Morgan Fountain) in the van advised the pit bull that had attacked the female victim, was still on the loose. Morgan advised I needed to have my gun out because he would come back.

I began approaching the female and when doing so I noticed blood splatter on the left side of the silver car and front left wheel, I also noted the position Ms. Nichelson was in. Ms. Nichelson was lying on her back, her left leg was positioned awkwardly next to her left side of her body as if something was broken. I observed her breathing very shallow and she was covered in blood, all over her shirt and face. I knelt down to Ms. Nichelson telling her who I was. I touched her right arm telling her I was here to help her. I began to place gauze all around the large gaping wounds on her neck. I radioed dispatch asking them how far out med unit was. They advised they were pulling up. I continued to render first aid until fire units arrived. While doing so the dog that attacked the victim came out from under the porch approximately 20 feet from me. The dog had a black and white face. I noticed the dog had red all over its mouth and head area. I drew my agency issued service weapon (Serial #RPG606) and as I started to point it toward the dog, it went back under the porch. I then continued to render aid and as I was doing so emergency personnel arrived.

I advised him of the situation and advised him of the wounds I observed on her. I advised the Emergency personnel I would stand watch for the dog while he helped Ms. Nichelson. Sergeant Blue Patterson arrived on scene just shortly after and we both stood watch while Ms. Nichelson was assisted. Numerous other emergency personnel arrived to assist Ms. Nichelson in an attempt to save her life. After a period of time passed I heard them say they were contacting the coroner. Sgt. Patterson and I continued watching for the dog. Sgt. Patterson advised I could begin collecting statements and he would maintain over watch.

At this point the homeowner arrived on scene and Sgt. Patterson spoke with him. I did not hear everything they spoke of. Major Gobble arrived on scene to assist as well. We had animal control be dispatched to our location to attempt to get the dog.

Due to having blood on my person I asked Sergeant Patterson if he had any cleaner with him. I went to his patrol car to obtain the cleaner and as I was returning to the driveway with Sergeant Patterson and Major Gobble I heard to gun shots accompanied by the yelping sound of a dog. Sgt. Patterson stated he had shot the dog because it came from under the porch and started toward him.

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I collected a written statement from Mr. Fountain whom was sitting in the van. I asked Mr. Fountain what

occurred today. Mr. Fountain stated he was driving by the Holloway residence and seen Ms. Nicholson's car and seen what appeared to him as a Halloween decoration. Mr. Fountain stated he pulled into the driveway noticing it was Ms. Nicholson laying on the ground. Mr. Fountain stated when he got out he went to her to try to help. Mr. Fountain stated when doing so the dog came after him biting him in the face. Mr. Fountain stated he ran over top of the car and back to his van to escape the dog. Mr. Fountain stated he called 9-1-1 and awaited our response.

Sergeant Patterson contacted the on call Criminal Investigations Division Detective (CID) to respond to the scene to process the scene. Lt. Dover, Sgt. Shelton, and Detective Stanfield arrived on the scene to process it and conduct interviews of the individuals involved. The scene was turned over to them at this time.

While still on scene animal control arrived and removed the dog. CID Detectives continued their investigation and interviewed multiple people along with speaking with family members whom arrived on scene. After a short period of time I was advised I could go back into service by Lt. D. Dover CID.

I have nothing further to report about this incident as of this time.

On the date of October 5th, 2017, I (Deputy A. McArthur #516) and Deputy J. Holcombe #547 were advised by Detective Shelton #595 of a wanted subject by the name of Dante Holloway driving a red Chevrolet 1500 extended cab headed north of 515.

Myself and Holcombe parked in the median area on 515 north across from cherry log street to observe traffic to see if we see the vehicle traveling north. At approximately 1630 hours we noticed a red Chevrolet 1500 extended cab pass us that matched the description we were giving. At 1634 hours I activated my emergency lights to initiate a traffic stop on 515 north just south of the entrance of Cherry Log Mountain. I approached the driver side window which was occupied by Melissa Holloway, and Holcombe approached the passenger side window which was occupied by Dante Holloway. Holcombe positively identified Dante and asked him to exit the vehicle and he did without incident and placed him under arrest for warrant numbers 17-952mw, and 17-953mw. Dante was handcuffed in the rear and was checked for proper fitting and double locked. I walked Dante back to the car and searched him incident to arrest in front of the camera. At this time Deputy Peterson #524 arrived on scene and Dante was placed in the back of his car.

At this time Holcombe had asked Melissa to exit the vehicle. Holcombe asked Melissa for consent to search the vehicle and she gave us consent to search. During the search of the vehicle small disruption bags commonly for narcotic use were found which one had white residue that tested positive for methamphetamine. Holcombe went to Peterson's car and spoke with Dante and Dante said "Those are little bags so I guess that's mine too."

At this time Dante was escorted to the Detention Center by Deputy Peterson and Melissa was released with no charges.
