Summary of Request:

Boyd Sturges, County Attorney, will provide details on a recommended Amendment to the Animal Services Ordinance. Section 1-12 is recommended to be amended to include an addition, Section E, as follows:

**Section 1-12 Confinement, Control, and Designation of Dangerous Animals**

**E. Notwithstanding other sections of this ordinance, any dog that kills a human being shall, at the owner's expense, immediately be taken into the custody of Franklin County Animal Services and housed for up to thirty days and shall at the end of this time be humanely destroyed by Franklin County Animal Services. Nothing herein shall prevent said dog's owner from voluntarily agreeing to have the dog humanely destroyed.**

The Board is asked to consider adopting this Animal Services Ordinance Amendment, effective immediately.
