Emphasizing the rise in "severe" injury dog bites in San Bernardino County, California between 2016 to 2023.

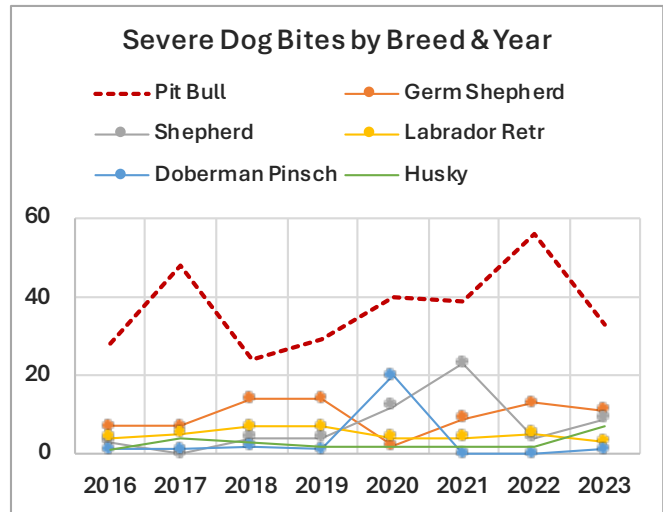
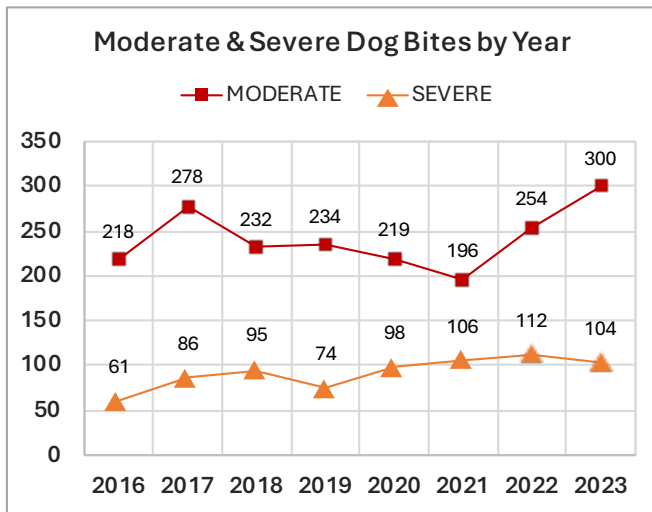
